

## **Enlarging with Adobe 8**

- 1. First click on Camera icon (in red below your cursor will turn into a plus sign drag a box around the part of the chart you wish to select)
- Using your mouse and the square cursor start at the upper left of the part of the chart you wish to select, press down the left mouse button and drag it across the chart only releasing the button at the bottom right of the part you wish to select.
- When you release your left mouse button the part of the chart you have selected will be highlighted in blue. If you didn't cover the part of the chart you wish to enlarge and print repeat this step until the blue masks all the part of the chart you want to print.



- 4. After you have selected the area of the file you wish to print and enlarge with Adobe click on the Printer icon (below).
- 5. A printer dialog box will appear (marked in red below).
- 6. Make sure Select Graphic has been checked.
- 7. One way to enlarge is to simply choose Fit to Printable Area in the Page Scaling dialog box. This will expand the part of the chart you have previously selected to fill an entire page.
- 8. Make sure Auto-Rotate and Center is selected and this will print the selected graphic on the page to the best advantage.
- 9. If you look at Zoom (it says 420% below), that tells you how much your selected graphic will be increased.



- 10. After you have made your selection another option is to allow Adobe 8 to choose how to cut apart the chart and copy it for you. To do that you select the entire graphic (camera button, mouse drag).
- 11. Once the part you wish to enlarge is masked in blue you click on the printer icon.
- 12. Now make sure you have Selected graphic chosen
- 13. Now in the Page Scaling drop down box choose the option Tile ALL Pages!
- 14. Now in the Tile scale box that appears (under Page Scaling), choose the % you wish to increase it by. For this demonstration I have chosen 1200%.
- 15. Look at the Preview pane on the right. The dotted lines (one is circled in red) show you where Adobe proposes to cut the graphic. The Preview pane also shows you the number of pages it will expand to. For this example my increasing to 1200% will require 6 printed pages. You can choose any size increase you wish but watch how many pages it might take!
- 16. Next to Tile Scale option if the Overlap option. If you wish you can choose to have each section overlap by a little so you are sure you have not cut any symbols in 1/2 or lost them between pages. After the chart prints I go over the pages and highlight the overlap on each page with a yellow highlighter so I know not to repeat those stitches.
- 17. Press OK when you are ready to print your pattern.
- 18. Please don't be concerned I used a weaving pattern to demonstrate but a cross stitch pattern works exactly the same way.
